Jazz n Cakes \$14,000 (\$10,000 this year and \$4000 that came in late from last year)  
Holly Christopher motioned to approve the May financial report. Monique Penney seconded  
Motion carried
- Passed out 2018-2019 budget handout and answered questions
  - rookie band jackets – Andy is considering this option but not definite it's the way he wants to go; it's dog-eared as a place holder for the funds at the moment. There's not enough money to cover the cost for the entire band. Discussion around subsidizing entire band rather than using the "phase in" approach starting with the rookies only
  - 2 yr lull; first full class without elementary band; no big trips
  - Guard uniforms - paid by district
  - Chaperone trip costs – will fund half the price for chaperones of mandatory band trips; chaperones are there working the entire trip; currently their rate is higher than the student rate since there are just two people to a room rather than four
  - Holly Christopher motioned to approve the budget as written; Audrey French seconded the motion; motion carried

#### Band Camp – Jen

- Band camp has lots of new volunteers; fun way to get involved and watch the kids perform
- Mini-Camp Sign up Genius is out with volunteer spots; Upbeat Club providing Chick fil A and Papa Johns for evening meals
- Band camp Sign up Genius will come out in the next couple of weeks; help is needed to fill first aid spots; lots of opportunities available during both the day and evening hours
