Unapproved Minutes

Directors report – Andy Carr

- Working on getting band lists out for next year – still some auditions “trickling” in so not finalized yet.
- Uniforms have been ordered. We decided on FJM design. Working on scheduling the measurement day.
- Color guard uniform artwork has been done
- Reveal video of next year’s show being worked on for spring concert 5/6
- Band concert 5/6 – working for a successful concert ☺
 - State testing has impacted practice schedule for this concert
 - Winds is behind other bands due to prep time needed for music hall show
- Senior concerto
 - More kids auditioned than we have had in the past few years
 - Quintet was one of the auditions this year
 - All auditions were great
 - Joe Keller and Emilee Warne doing solo concertos + quintet will do a feature too
- May Schedule details
 - Get from website
- Blue Wisp concern went great!
 - 60% of the theater filled (approx. 350-400 ppl)
 - \$580 donations, \$200 donated back to jazz hall of fame (pending results of whether we get a Lakota facilities fee)
 - Lots of community (non-band) ppl came – good things to say about LW band kids/parents/etc.
- Symphonic Winds will likely travel next year
 - Looking into Music For All National Concert Band Festival
 - Considering other options
- Next year’s band schedule is “out of control”
 - Solo & Ensemble on president’s day weekend – meeting with OMEA Tuesday 4/30 about potentially rescheduling that
 - Large group contest on first weekend of spring break – working on idea to do large group event between LE/LW outside of OMEA
 - Jazz N Cakes date is potentially changing
 - 3/28 is currently scheduled date but this runs into winter guard championship
 - 4/18 is another option but historically the attendance gets worse when the date moves later due to the weather being nicer
 - Currently deciding whether facilities are available and if we should move to 4/18
- Instrumentation still an issue for next year’s concert bands
 - Clarinets still lacking numbers
 - Many kids have switched but due to other situations (not all band related) retention is a problem
- Freshman band room – Mr. Racic been dealing with construction noise and debris recently; was unable to hold class on one of the days this week.

Jazz n Cakes – Candi Vance

- 2019 stats:
 - 9000 raffle tickets printed the day of the event
 - 64 raffle baskets
 - 21 silent auction baskets
 - Total value = \$11,000 in prizes
 - 16 vendor booths
 - We served 3000 pancakes, 1300 plates, 794 people
- Looking for people to take over the event next year as the entire leadership team is senioring out
