Proposed Itinerary

Day One – Monday, November 25, 2013

- Arrival** Welcome to New York! Arrivals could be anytime throughout the day.
- Hotel** Meet your Gateway Tour Manager will assist with hotel check-in.
- Free Time** Once you have checked in, you are free to explore the city on your own.

Day Two – Tuesday, November 26, 2013

- Free Time** Today is free for you to explore on your own. Some suggestions include a cruise to the Statue of Liberty and Ellis Island, a walk through Central Park, a ride to the top of the Empire State Building, or a 'hop on/hop off' bus tour through the city. Your Tour Manager will be available for assistance.
- Broadway Show** Attend a Broadway show. From musicals and comedies to dramas and mysteries, Broadway has a show for everyone (based on a \$110.00 ticket value).



Day Three – Wednesday, November 27, 2013

- City Tour** A licensed New York City guide will join you on your motorcoach and narrate your tour as you explore the different neighborhoods and sights of this amazing city. Some sights you are sure to see include St. Patrick's Cathedral, Little Italy and Chinatown, Battery Park and Ground Zero.
- South Street Seaport** With its rich and diverse history, this cultural marketplace along the lower Manhattan waterfront is a gateway to the harbor. The neighborhood offers restaurants, attractions and shops for every taste.
- 911 Memorial** Visit the site of the September 11, 2001 terrorist attacks on the United States. The names of the nearly 3,000 victims are inscribed on bronze panels lining the two pools. Waterfalls cascade down all four sides of each pool, creating a special place for remembrance and reflection. The surrounding plaza is filled with oak trees and a callery pear known as the Survivor Tree, which was nursed back to health after surviving the 9/11 attacks (subject to availability).
- 911 Museum** The Memorial Museum, located at the World Trade Center site, is to bear solemn witness to the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001 and February 26, 1993. The Museum honors the nearly 3,000 victims of these attacks and all those who risked their lives to save others (subject to scheduled opening date).
- Shopping or Exploring** Enjoy free time to shop around Chinatown and Little Italy.
- Dinner** SPQR in Little Italy
- Radio City Christmas Spectacular** Attend the Radio City Christmas Spectacular – America's most beloved holiday show starring the world-famous Rockettes (based on an \$85.00 ticket value).
