Upbeat Club will share the process and deadline for the Kenworthy scholarship at least a week prior to state competition. The process is as follows:

- Letters of nomination may be written by any Marching Band Student. They should explain why the senior they are nominating fits the criteria above.

 Marching Band students include the Color Guard.
- Signed nomination letters should be deposited, in a sealed envelope, in the envelope posted on the band room white board no later than the day of the state competition.
- The award letters will be reviewed by the Upbeat Club Exec board for decision.
 The scholarship recipient will be determined by the supporting examples
 showing the candidate's qualities vs. the criteria, not by the quality of the
 letter or the quantity of the letters.
- Decision will be made prior to the Marching Firebirds end of season concert and the scholarship will be awarded by the Upbeat Club President (or any other Upbeat Club Exec) at the concert.
