

Uniform Packing for Macy's

Woodwinds turn in Tues 11/12 4:45-6pm

Color Guard/Percussion/FC turn in Thur 11/14 5:45-7:30pm

Brass turn in Wed 11/13 5:15-6:30pm

Final Make up Fri 11/15 2:30-4pm

ALL BAND: Roll your parka and bring it to turn in.

Band:

1. Shako & shako box - both items have masking tape with your name on them. Add your chaperone's number (below) in black sharpie to the masking tape on your shako & shako box. Put shako in box.
2. Put these items in your shako box: 2 pairs of gloves (2 right white, 2 black left, in good condition!), 2 pairs of black socks (at least calf high), and your gauntlets.
3. Get a 2 gallon Ziploc bag. Write your name and chaperone number on the outside of the bag (large and legible) in black sharpie. **Clean and polish** your black marching shoes. Replace the shoelaces if they are worn or compromised. We don't want broken shoelaces half way thru the parade! Write your last name on the green insole of EACH shoe with a black sharpie. Put your shoes in the Ziploc bag.

Sousa players:

1. Put your beret, gloves, socks, and gauntlets in the 2 gallon Ziploc bag with your shoes.

Color guard:

1. Put your dress and sweater on a hanger. You will receive a garment bag for your items when turning them in.
2. Get a 2 gallon Ziploc bag. Write your name and chaperone number on the outside of the bag (large and legible) in black sharpie. Put your shoes in the bag along with your earmuffs.
3. Put your name on your crinoline. They will be packed separately in their own box.
4. **You will pack your own tights.**
