

CHAPERONE UNIFORM RESPONSIBILITIES

1. You will have 2-3 boxes with your student's uniforms in them. All of your boxes will be labeled with your name and have your band kids listed on them. One box will have the actual uniforms in their garment bags. The summer uniforms will be in the bottom of this box. The shakos, shoes, socks, berets and gloves will be in the other 1-2 boxes.
2. Uniforms will be your responsibility to pass out the night before the first performance.
3. When checking the band members in marching uniform, look for these things:
 - a. Males should be cleanly shaven
 - b. No jewelry should be visible – no earrings!
 - c. Black t-shirt should be worn under the marching uniform
 - d. Black calf length socks
 - e. Black Drillmasters
 - f. Gauntlets
4. When checking summer uniforms:
 - a. Males should be cleanly shaven
 - b. No jewelry should be visible – no earrings!
 - c. White shortie socks should be worn with white gym shoes
 - d. The only belt that is acceptable to wear is the khaki web belt
5. After the last performance it will be your responsibility to collect the uniforms and pack them back into their boxes and seal the boxes back up for shipping. Uniforms should be put back into their garment bags with no pins on them (if there are pins!) Gauntlets should be placed in the garment bag with the marching uniform.
6. Help load the boxes back onto the truck.
7. When the luggage returns to school, it will be your responsibility to pass out the summer uniforms, gloves, berets and marching shoes to your group before they pick up their luggage.
