

# UNIFORM PACKING FOR ROSE PARADE

## 1. Regular Band Member –

- Shako in the shako box-you should already have your name in the shako and on the box. Add the chaperone number to the masking tape on both. Please make sure that your shako is clean. If it is not, leave it in the uniform room ASAP!
- Also in the shako box should be 2 pair of gloves (2 right white, 2 black left) in great condition and 2 pair of black socks (at least calf high).
- Clean and polished** black marching shoes should be put in a 2 gallon Ziploc bag with your name on the outside of the bag along with your chaperone number (large and legible). Please make sure that you have put your last name inside your shoes with a sharpie (on the green insoles). Also, replace any shoelaces that are looking iffy. We don't want broken shoelaces half way thru the parade!
- In a separate Ziploc bag place your summer khakis, your red polo shirt and your khaki web belt (if you have one). They should be neatly folded with the air out of the bag so that they stay neat and wrinkle-free! This bag should be labeled the same way. Please try on your summer uniform to make sure it still fits! Your white shoes and socks will be your responsibility to pack in your luggage.
- Sousa** players will place their beret into their Ziploc bag.

## 2. Color guard Band Member –

- Put your costume and your full warm-up (pants and jacket) onto 2 hangers and place in the garment bag with your name on. Uniform bags will be left in the color guard room.
- Mark a 2 gallon Ziploc bag with your name and your chaperone number. Put into this bag your body tight, jazz shoes, Alison's white shoes, your red polo, your "Best of West" t-shirt and your black shorts. Use a second bag if needed!

- The large Ziploc /Hefty bags can be found at Krogers, WalMart, etc.
