We have received our information for the Beavercreek Jazz Festival on Saturday, March $4^{\rm th}$. All Lakota Main Campus jazz bands will be performing. Please review the information below carefully, as there are separate times for each of the bands included in this handout.

WHEN: Saturday, March 4^{th} . (Please note arrival times for students below.)

WHERE: Beavercreek High School 2660 Dayton-Xenia Rd

Beavercreek, OH 45434.

Merge onto I-75 N.

Then in 21.75 miles, Merge onto I-675 N via EXIT 43 toward Columbus.

Then in 13.14 miles, Merge onto US-35 E via EXIT 13A toward Xenia.

Then in 3.92 miles, Turn left onto Factory Rd.

Then in 0.65 miles, Turn left onto Dayton Xenia Rd.

Then in 0.36 miles, 2660 Dayton Xenia Rd, Beaver Creek, OH 45434, is on the right.

Estimated Driving Time: 45 minutes.

TRANSPORTATION: On your own.

STUDENT DRESS CODE: Regular concert dress as described in our handbook.

STUDENT REPORT TIMES:

Following a designated warm-up time, the <u>Eastside Jazz</u> <u>Ensemble</u> will perform on the <u>Jazz Bistro Stage</u> at 11:40 am and be finished (after the clinic) at 12:45 pm.

Following a designated warm-up time, the <u>West Jazz Ensemble</u> will perform in the <u>Auditorium</u> at 12:10 pm and be finished (after the clinic) at 1:05 pm.

Following a designated warm-up time, the <u>West Jazz Combo</u> will perform in the <u>Auditorium</u> at 1:50 pm and be finished (after the clinic) at 2:45 pm.

Following a designated warm-up time, the <u>East 2 O'clock</u> <u>Jazz Ensemble</u> will perform in the <u>Auditorium</u> at 4:20 pm and be finished (after the clinic) at 5:15 pm.

After clinics have ended the students may stay at the school to watch other bands or they may go home.

SPECIAL EVENT NOTES: All audience members must enter the auditorium <u>before</u> each group's performance begins. Doors are only opened between performing groups. Free admission is offered for all Saturday performances other than the professional performance on Saturday evening.
