Those events give you an opportunity to play the same music in different settings. **Honor band auditions** – there's a lot of things going on in this situation – needing to come up with something new – waiting for approval from Mason to do in their facility – perhaps will happen there. Half the size – couldn't come up with a way to do auditions like usual. Going to offer spots similar to a usual year (but half the size) offering to the smaller schools, figure out the instrumentation, then divide with the larger schools. We are trying to make it work. **Solo and Ensemble** – all virtual – did virtual in the fall. We are still planning to do fall virtual solo and ensemble – but we won't have as many rooms to set up.
